- NBSD Updates (Neighborhood Based Service Delivery Program):
 - Mark McKinney:
 - Crime is up, calls for service is up by 80 so 2.5 calls/day
 - Cases are up 32
 - Arrests were almost double: 52

- Biggest area: 3104 University a lot of people call from the Kum & Go
 - Usually because it's the safest place to call from
- Nothing of GREAT concern, burglaries are down
- Domestics had a bit of an uptick
- Football game last week went out so that's good because it brings a lot of people to the area, parking was OK and traffic was good for that (Drake does a good job)
- Board members and people they know in the neighborhood have noticed a lot more people just walking around or looking into cars and looking into homes than in the past
 - Possible urine containers call NID
 - If people are wandering through private property, let them know
 - We are NOT saying to send all homeless people to jail—if something uncomfortable is happening, NBSD has services and teams for them
 - "The frequency we take them to jail is extremely low."
